

**Village of Napoleonville**  
**Minutes of Regular Council Meeting**  
**January 26, 2024**

The Village of Napoleonville held a Regular Council Meeting at the Administration Building Meeting Chamber on Friday, January 26, 2024. The session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Animashaun, the Clerk being present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Alderwoman Converse, followed by a moment of silence.

**Present:** Mayor Animashaun, Alderwoman Kia Converse and Alderwoman April Williams. Alderwoman Velma Jupiter was absent. A quorum to conduct business was declared present by Mayor Animashaun.

**Approval of the Minutes**

Upon a motion by Alderwoman Converse, seconded by Alderwoman Williams, the minutes from the Regular Council meeting on December 11, 2023, were approved. With a unanimous agreement from the Board, Mayor Animashaun declared the motion carried.

**Financial Reports**

Upon a motion by Alderwoman Converse, seconded by Alderwoman Williams, the Board agreed to accept the financial reports from December 2023. With a unanimous agreement from the Board, Mayor Animashaun declared the motion carried.

**New Business**

Alderwoman Converse motioned, Alderwoman Williams second “THAT” the Board opens a public comment session. Upon a unanimous agreement by the Board, Mayor Animashaun declared the motion carried.

Alderwoman Converse motioned, Alderwoman Williams second “THAT” the Village of Napoleonville will resume responsibility for the Mardi Gras parade, it will be hosted the Saturday before Mardi Gras at 1:00 pm and the route will be the same as previous years, and the plan to host the parade will be announced at the July regular council meeting. Upon a unanimous agreement by the Board, Mayor Animashaun declared the motion carried.

Alderwoman Converse motioned, Alderwoman Williams second “THAT” the Board approve for the Mayor to speak with Sheriff Leland Falcon on Monday, January 29, 2024, at 11:00 am, to discuss security issues for the Mardi Gras parade on February 10, 2024, and there will be a special council meeting on Thursday, February 1, 2024, at 5:00 pm to finalize the security plans for the parade.

Alderwoman Converse motioned and Alderwoman Williams second, “THAT” the public comments session be closed. The Board unanimously agreed and Mayor Animashaun declared the motion carried.
